## **Pre-Notification for Pine Beetle Spraying:**

**ALL ABOUT TREE CARE** will be in the Trails @ Hiwan June 10th thru the 14th. Spraying the ponderosa pines in the common area to prevent pine beetle. The pesticide product being used is Permethrin SFR. I will also be spraying the residential properties that would like to be included in this group rate of \$10 per tree at the same time.

Customers that have sprayed with me in the past are on my schedule this year and will receive a confirmation call two days prior to the day your street is scheduled. Your trees will not be sprayed if I do not get a confirmation back from you.

<u>NEW</u> Customers are welcome, but must call beforehand to get on the list <u>@ #303-944-5519</u>, or email me <u>@ wes2aatc@gmail.com</u>. I will be glad to answer any questions you may have, along with inspecting your property at no charge, to ensure that the appropriate spray services are scheduled to best suit your particular property.

## PREPARE FOR TREE SPRAYING CHECKLIST:

- Close all windows around the house.
- Keep yourself and your children inside while I'm spraying or feel free to leave before I start, but do not return until completion of the spraying. Stay out of the treated area for at least one hour after to allow the trees to completely dry.
- Pick up kids toys that are out or anything that you would not want any potential spray drift on.
- Pets must stay inside during the application and for at least an hour after, to ensure plenty of time for the trees to completely dry.
- Don't forget your pets food and water bowls, dog bones, or chew toys of any sort.
- Remove any bird feeders, bird baths, salt blocks and keep them inside during, and for at least an hour after the spraying. Permanent birdhouses or bird feeders can be covered with a black trash bag or plastic of any sort.
- Please don't have food or drinks sitting out, including dishes, eating utensils, etc.
- I encourage you to move bbq grills, patio furniture and any other items that are directly under a tree that is going to be treated. An alternative to moving things away from the trees is to cover these items with plastic.
- Vegetable gardens should also be covered with plastic. Vegetable plants in containers should be moved inside or can be covered as well.

Please notify your neighbors that you will be spraying so they are aware of what I am doing, and can take the necessary actions to be prepared for the tree spraying as well.
